



Procurement Policy

Srisawad Capital 1969 Public Company Limited

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1. Objectives

To ensure that the procurement processes of Srisawad Capital 1969 Public Company Limited (the “Company”) and its subsidiaries are efficient, effective, and aligned in the same direction toward sustainable development. By building stakeholder confidence through transparent, fair, and auditable procurement operations, the Company has established the Procurement Policy for the Company and its subsidiaries as follows:

1. Procurement shall consider quality, price, quantity, service, and responsiveness, with an emphasis on efficiency and effectiveness, while also taking into account **Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG)** responsibilities.
2. Procurement must be conducted with transparency, fairness, and accountability. It must strictly comply with relevant rules, regulations, and laws, supported by sound internal controls and auditability.
3. Procurement shall focus on business ethics, ensuring no exploitation of suppliers or service providers. Accurate, complete, clear, and disclosed information must be provided, treating all suppliers and service providers with integrity and equality. Furthermore, business confidentiality obtained from suppliers and service providers must be strictly maintained.
4. Joint procurement shall be encouraged for the maximum benefit of the Company and its subsidiaries.
5. The Company places high importance on **Anti-Corruption**. We do not support or allow any officers and employee, personnel, or related departments to solicit or accept any gifts, assets, or bribes from suppliers or service providers in any procurement case.

This policy shall be effective from December 1, 2022, onwards.
